About Our Hybrid Program

Community Safety Consultants strongly recommends that students attending this program be at a college level of learning. It is expected that all students will have good study habits and have the ability to independently study prior to all class sessions. This is required in order to be prepared for the many skill sessions involved in the program. The curriculum will demand a great amount of reading in order to be prepared for skill sessions. Expect to spend at least 10-15 hours of study outside of class per week, plus time to practice skills. All lectures are provided on-line. In-Class sessions are dedicated to skills only. In order to complete the class, all of the on-line lectures and on-line quizzes must be satisfactorily completed. Reliable Internet access is necessary to complete this class.

Class Attendance

While the on-line study portion of the class can be done at a time and place to fit the student's personal schedule, the in-class schedule for skill sessions **MUST** be followed. ALL SCHEDULED CLASSES ARE MANDATORY... Our class is approved by The State of New Jersey Department of Health. They are the licensing agency that will issue the EMT certifications. The NJDOH regulations governing the training of EMT candidates mandate that all scheduled classes must be attended by the student for the full length of the scheduled sessions.

Dress Code

Students attending the CSC Hybrid EMT program **MUST** be properly attired. Proper attire consists of a White Collared shirt without any decorations or logos. Polo Shirts are acceptable. Tee shirts are prohibited. Pants must be worn. Black or dark blue are the only acceptable colors. Jeans or stretch pants are prohibited. Shoes (dark colored) must be worn for safety reasons. The entire foot must be covered securely by the shoe. Work boots or EMS boots are preferred.

In Class all students must wear a wrist watch with a second hand (analog, not digital), must have a stethoscope and wear the name tag which will be provided. All students **MUST** be neatly dressed in the student uniform at all class sessions. Stethoscopes are available for purchase at our office, or available at retail/online stores.

Text Books

The AAOS 12th Edition Premier Package EMT Textbook is required for this class. Books may be purchased on the first day of class. On the first day of class, a course ID will be assigned to the student for the online component of the class. CSC will provide a student handbook to each student. This handbook outlines our policies, procedures, guidelines and expectations of the program. It will serve as a valuable resource during your education, and practice as an EMT.

New Jersey Registration

All students must register with the New Jersey Department of Health prior to attending the first day of class. This is a NJDOH requirement. Please visit https://njems.njlicns.net/acr/create_account.jsp and follow the directions for creating an account. Students must answer the legal questionnaire at the bottom of the form. On the first day of class, CSC will register you for our class with the NJDOH. You must bring your NJDOH issued ID number and login information.

National Registry Test

Once you have completed the CSC EMT Hybrid EMT course, we will certify to the NJDOH that you are eligible for certification testing. You will register for the exam through the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians website (<https://www.nremt.org/>). The cost for the testing is approximately \$104.00 per attempt. For those covered under the NJ Training Fund, your initial attempt is paid for by the fund. Subsequent attempts are not covered. You must be present on the date you select, as you will be charged for any changes in dates or no-shows.

Dear prospective EMT,

Welcome to the EMT program at Community Safety Consultants! We are excited to begin your education as an Emergency Medical Technician. As we approach the first day of class, please come no later than 7:30 prepared with the following to ensure a smooth registration process:

1. CPR Card (or email for eCards) – Are Required for the first day of Class.
 - A current BLS/Healthcare Provider card is required prior to the start of class - if you need a class, check our CPR schedule at www.communitysafetyconsultants.com. You will upload your card on the first day of class.
2. NJ OEMS 6 digit ID number, and log in information
 - You'll need to make sure you have an active ID, and have logged in to: <https://njems.njlics.net/jsp/index.jsp> You need to apply for NJ EMT Initial Standard Certification - this is required prior to the orientation so we can register you with the state as attending the program.
3. NREMT ID number you will need this for us to validate your eligibility.
 - You'll need to make sure you have an account, and have created an application for EMT certification.

4. Laptop/Tablet (A laptop or tablet is required for Orientation Day and all in Class dates especially for days we are testing during the program. We do not furnish electronics for you to test with) - this will speed up the registration process for the online textbook and state registration.
5. **You must read our student handbook prior to the start of class:**

Signed forms from the back of the student handbook will be uploaded to your student file. If you are a minor, these will be signed by your parent. If you are an adult, you may sign them yourself.
6. A white polo or button-down shirt, navy blue or black dress pants or BDU's, a belt, and black safety shoes (black boots are preferred you will also need non latex medical gloves for all classes including but not limited to Orientation Day).

On the first day of class, we ask that you arrive no later than 7:30 to secure your spot. We will review the handbook, covering the operating rules/regulations of the program, and take an assessment on the information from the hand book. You will meet and greet the students and staff, register with the state, and orient yourselves to the online processes for the program.

Our staff are ready and willing to help you on your way to becoming an EMT and beyond. Our facilities will use simulation manikins in teaching and scenario-based learning for the closest to life training we can provide.
