PRE-COURSE REQUIREMENTS

1. You must have in your possession a BLS CPR bring it to the 1st day of class session (a must!!!)
2. All applicants must be at least 18 years of age or older.
3. The course fee is \$ 275.00. Make checks or money orders payable to CSC. No refunds for unsuccessful completion of course or no show. There will be no refunds for dropping out without one week notice prior to course start date. Fees collected represent no income to the American Heart Association.
4. Please bring a 2 inch binder with you to class. You will put all of your class information in this binder. DO NOTFORGET!
5. Other AHA Course materials will be handed out at class.
6. THE FIRST NITE THERE WILL BE A WRITTEN (BLS TEST) AND SKILLS EVALUATION. BE PREPARED TO BE EVALUATED ON ALL YOUR CPR SKILLS. THESE INCLUDE: ADULT, CHILD, AND INFANT CPR AND FBAO. ALL STUDENTS MUST PASS THIS EVALUATION IN ORDER TO MOVE ON. Please take the time to practice, preferably with an AHA CPR instructor. Until you are proficient in your skills.

Plan on teaching CPR courses (not just to have instructor credentials). A minimum of 2 courses processed thru CSC a year (also must be monitored within 2 year period) must be taught to keep your instructor credentials current.
