STANDARD FIRST AID - LEVEL 1

This introductory First Aid Course covers skills in patient assessment, medical emergency identification, splinting and bandaging. It is suitable for those seeking a brief course in first aid. This would include youth groups, athletic club personal, and restaurant employees among others. Also, ideal for companies looking to distribute first aid knowledge to a large number of employees at a low cost.



STANDARD FIRST AID - LEVEL 2

This course covers all the topics of Level 1, but in greater detail. Advanced splinting, lifting and moving will be covered. Oxygen administration and the taking of vital signs (including blood pressure, pulse & respiratory rate) will be practiced.

Recommended for corporate and industrial first aid teams, or wherever a more extensive first aid course is required.

More "Hands on" practice is given.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN EMT-B

Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) are specially trained to treat illness and injuries where they happen, then transport the patient to the hospital. EMT certification is required to work at any level in the pre-hospital environment. Our EMT program meets the standards set forth by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

The EMT training program offered at Community Safety Consultants (CSC) will teach the life saving skills students will need to attain a New Jersey State EMT certification. After completing the 120 hour EMT program, students will be eligible to take the New Jersey State Department of Health examination for EMT-B certification. They are then qualified to begin a career in emergency medical services, saving lives.

Professional level CPR is a **prerequisite** for the EMT program. This CPR training can be taken at Community Safety Consultants. Attendance to all classes is mandatory as per the NJ Department of Health in order to be eligible to take the EMT test.

DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSE

The Defensive Driving Course contains the most recent research on preventing death and injuries due to traffic accidents. New safety issues addressed include airbags, anti-lock braking systems, safety belts, child restraints, headrests and much more. The state of NJ has established a 2-point vehicle reduction program for NJ Drivers who satisfactorily complete a registered Defensive Driving Course, like this one. NJ Insurance Commissioner, Elizabeth Randle, advises that the drivers who complete a six-hour Defensive Driving Course can now save a minimum of 5% from the base rate for bodily injury, property damage, personal injury and collision coverage for three-year period.

**A one-time State of NJ processing/validation fee of \$10.00 per student (not included in course registration fee) covers the point reduction and/or insurance discount. Please note that the instructor will collect this fee before class.
